Exclusion from nursery for 48 hrs from the last time

Temperature 24 hours away from nursery from when the

Antibiotics To be kept off for 24 hours after the initial dose

Conjunctivitis (Eye Infection) Treated and stopped weeping

Skin infections(e.g. Scabies,

Impetigo & Ringworm) Treated and cleared

Ear infection Child should be kept away until treated & well.

Throat/Chest infection Child should be away for 2-3 days until treated

& visibly well.

Chicken Pox Child should be kept away until blisters have dried up

Measles 7-10 days from onset of rash

Rubella(German measles) 4 days from onset of rash

Mumps Until swelling has gone

Whooping cough 21 days from onset of cough

Scarlet Fever Child can return back when been on anti-biotic for

3-4 days & no longer have a rash

Child should be kept away until spots are dried up

& disappearing.
