## ABSENCE FROM NURSERY

Exclusion from nursery for 48 hrs from the last time vomiting or diarrhoea took place.

24 hours away from nursery from when the Temperature went down.

To be kept off for 24 hours after the initial dose

Treated and stopped weeping

Treated and cleared

Child should be kept away until treated & well.

Child should be away for 2-3 days until treated & visibly well.

Child should be kept away until blisters have dried up

7-10 days from onset of rash

4 days from onset of rash

Until swelling has gone

21 days from onset of cough

Child can return back when been on anti-biotic for 3-4 days & no longer have a rash

Child should be kept away until spots are dried up & disappearing.

Until treated
