

| <u>ILLNESS</u> | <u>ABSENCE FROM DAYCARE</u> |
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| Sickness & Diarrhoea | Until vomiting and diarrhoea have stopped and there |
| Conjunctivitis (Eye infection) | Until discharge has stopped, or treatment commenced. |
| Scabies | Until successfully treated |
| Impetigo | Until lesions are crusted or healed, or 48 hours after treatment has commenced |
| Ringworm | Until treatment has started |
| Ear infection | Until treatment has commenced for 24 hours and child is well |
| Throat/Chest Infection | Child should be away for 2.3 days until treated & visibly well |
| Chicken Pox | Child should be away until blisters have dried up |
| Measles | 7 - 10 days from onset of rash |
| Rubella (German Measles) | 4 days from onset of rash |
| Mumps | Until swelling has gone |
| Whooping Cough | 21 days from onset of cough |
| Scarlet Fever | Child can return back when been on Anti-biotics for 3 - 4 days & no longer have a rash |
| Hand, Foot & Mouth | Child should be kept away until they are feeling better |
| Head lice | Until treated |
| Anti biotics | Off nursery for 24 hours from intial dose of antibiotics |
| High Temperature | Child is require to stay at home for 24hours if they have a high temperature. |

| HOSPITAL TREATMENT | ABSENCE FROM DAYCARE |
|---------------------------|----------------------------------|
| Tonsils & Adenoids | One week from operation |
| Grommets Only | Two days from operation |
| Asthma Attack | Twenty Four Hours from discharge |
| Other Hospital treatment | As advised by Doctor |
